Glovers Lake Road 2022 Resurfacing Pleasanton Township, Manistee County

The Manistee County Road Commission (MCRC) has announced that construction will begin for the resurfacing of 1.62 mile of Glovers Lake Road from East of Zilch Road to East of Keillor Road in Pleasanton Township beginning on or about July 5, 2022 and the project is expected to be completed by or before August 26, 2022.

This will be the final segment of the 6.50 miles total length of Glovers Lake Road to be improved between M-22 in the un-incorporated Village of Arcadia to State Highway US-31.

According to Mark Sohlden, Road Commission Manager, the scope of construction work will include crushing and shaping of the existing blacktop pavement, trenching, aggregate base widenings, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) paving, aggregate shoulders, intersection improvements, pavement markings, permanent signing, and miscellaneous improvements. The new HMA pavement will be constructed at a width of 28' which will include two 11' wide traffic lanes and 3' wide partially paved shoulders.

The project will be funded with Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds, Federal Highway Infrastructure Program COVID funds (up to \$100,000), State Category D funds, and MCRC funds and the project low bid of \$661,819.94 was submitted by Elmer's Crane and Dozer, Inc. of Traverse City, Michigan to the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) in Lansing on April 1, 2022.

According to Sohlden, Glovers Lake Road within the limits of the project will be closed to "through traffic" during construction and "through traffic" will be detoured via Gilbert Road, Norconk Road, and Butwell Road with proper detour signing and barricading. "Local traffic" and access to residential and commercial drives within the limits of the project will be maintained at all times with minimal disruption, and Emergency Services vehicle access to and through the site will be maintained at all times during construction.

The Manistee County Road Commission will be replacing one cross road culvert near Letteau Road during the week of June 27th in advance of the resurfacing project.
