The Manistee County Road Commission will accept applications from qualified individuals for SEASONAL Truck Drivers with other duties as assigned. These positions will be for up to an 89 working days period (approximately November 30, 2020 through March 26, 2021 or longer subject to actual days worked) consisting of up to 40 hours per week. The hourly wage for the position will be \$18.00 per hour. Overtime may be worked on an as-needed basis. Seasonal employees are not eligible for benefits.

Applicants must possess a current CDL with A endorsement and air brakes, medical card, excellent driving record and able to pass new hire and random drug and alcohol screens.

Candidates experienced in snowplowing and road and bridge construction and maintenance operations are preferred.
